



Social Distancing Etiquette

	<p>Maintain social distancing protocols:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Limiting the number of people at any one time which allows for members and employees to easily maintain at least six-foot distance from one another at all practicable times. <input type="checkbox"/> A staff member is posted at the door to ensure that the maximum number of members and staff in the facility set forth above is not exceeded. <input type="checkbox"/> All employees have been instructed to maintain at least six feet distance from members and from each other, except employees may momentarily come closer when necessary to accept payment, or as otherwise necessary.
	<p>Symptom checks are being conducted at the entrance of the Club.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Staff members will be sent home if they exhibit any signs of illness. <input type="checkbox"/> Club Members will be sent home if they exhibit any signs of illness.
	<p>Behaviors to modify:</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <input type="checkbox"/> Cough or sneeze into a cloth or tissue. Use your elbow if a cloth or tissue is not available. <input type="checkbox"/> Don't shake hands or engage in any unnecessary physical contact.

Additionally, we have done the following:

- Placed signs outside the club reminding people to be at least six feet apart, including when in line.
- Placed tape or other markings at least six feet apart in front of the reception desk area for proper distancing. On sidewalks at public entrances with signs directing customers to use the markings to maintain distance.
- Separated areas from delivery areas to prevent people from gathering.
